What is the holiday of Passover?

The eight-day festival of Passover is celebrated this year from sundown on Friday, April 19 until after nightfall on Saturday, April 27, 2019. Passover commemorates the exodus of the Jews from Egypt and will be celebrated with festive “Seder” dinners on April 19 and 20, 2019. Other holiday observances include restricting the consumption of leavened products such as bread and pasta, instead eating unleavened matzah.
